

# NORTHERN TERMINUS TRAFFIC STUDY

## COMMUNITY MEETING #2 NOVEMBER 2, 2019

The Chicago Department of Transportation and Illinois Department of Transportation have initiated a Northern Terminus Traffic Study (NTTS) that complements the North Lake Shore Drive Phase I Study from Grand Avenue to Hollywood Avenue. The purpose of the NTTS is to specifically address the transportation issues affecting the Edgewater community and the 48<sup>th</sup> Ward that are related to the operation of the northern terminus.

### STUDY GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

- Improve **movement of vehicles** to/from NLSA while preserving **neighborhood quality of life**
- Improve **pedestrian and bicycle infrastructure** to enhance safety and mobility, consistent with Chicago Complete Streets Guidelines
- Reduce **potential conflicts** between different traffic modes and improve **safety** for all users
- Achieve improved **redistribution of traffic** better tailored to roadway context, specifically regarding Sheridan Road and Broadway
- Eliminate **manual traffic control** at the intersection of Hollywood Avenue, Sheridan Road and North Lake Shore Drive

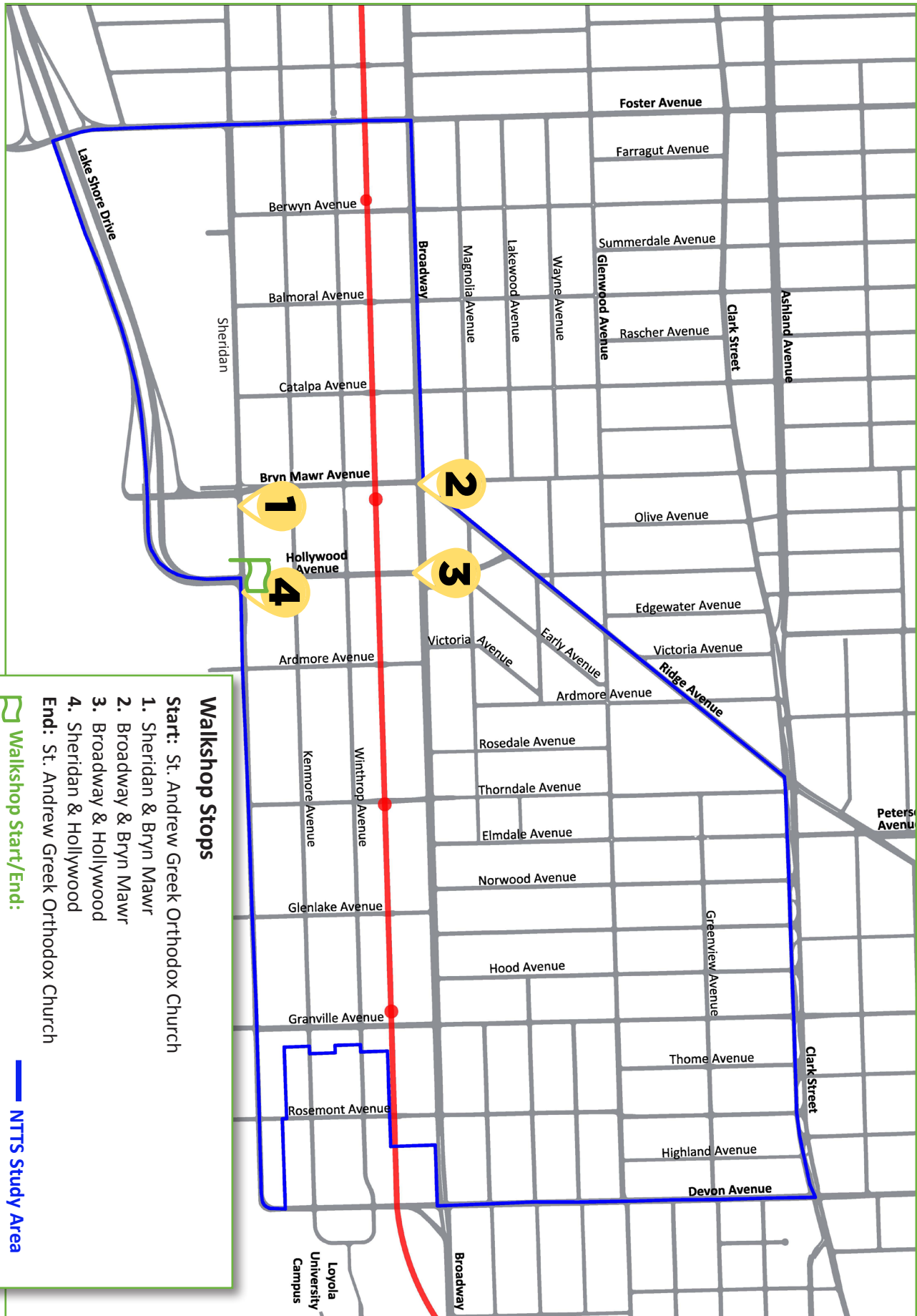
